## **Pupil Voice**



**FMW & RAL:** In EYFS we have been learning about how plants grow and how we can take care of them.

<u>1CF</u>: In Year 1, we have been learning about the 7 different continents. We also researched about the similarities and differences between the UK and Tanzania. We looked at the at a 5 day weather forecast for each country. We studied about 'Jane Goodall' a famous author who became a researcher and helped look after Chimpanzees and protect the species.

<u>1/2CW:</u> To celebrate all the fabulous learning about Mexico we did this half term, we ended the topic by making some traditional Mexican guacamole and salsa to try with nachos!

<u>2CH:</u> In Geography, we have been learning about where Mexico is situated in our world, as well as famous destinations and landmarks such as Mexico City and Chichen Itza.

<u>3CL:</u> We looked at how Coal mining effected our locality, looking at features and how it has changed from the Victorian times.

<u>3/4SW:</u> Children looked at the artist Naum Gabo who created art using the printing technique. Children created their own piece of art using Gabo's printing techniques.

<u>4CH:</u> In Science, we looked at Electricity. We learned about how electricity works, electrical appliances and how to make circuits. We even designed and made our own switches!

<u>5MW:</u> In our Jigsaw lessons we have looked at how we view our bodies and the effects that alcohol and smoking can have on our health.

<u>5RS:</u> Year 5 have studied our solar and lunar system.

<u>6DA:</u> In our Jigsaw lessons we have looked at "Healthy Me" which focuses on our mental and physical wellbeing.

<u>6KM:</u> This half-term we have been focusing on light and how it travels. We have been investigating with different types of lenses to see which ones are the most effective.

# School Council News:


Junior Managers have been listening to children in reception read
